


**Thrifty**  
12" Nine Patch Block

Block of the Month



*Baby it's cold outside ... well at least in some parts of the country.  
Here in Santa Barbara we can only dream of snow.  
Stitch up this simple nine patch block in icy blues.*

**Cutting**

*White or white on white:*

Cut 8 (2-1/2") squares.

*Light Blue:*

Cut four 4-1/2" squares.


*Medium Blue:*

Cut 8 (2-1/2") squares.

Cut 1 (4-1/2") square.

**Assembly**


1. Sew the white and medium blue 2-1/2" squares together. Press to blue. Make 4 four patch units.



2. Arrange the four patch units with the plain squares to make the Thrifty block.

Sew into rows. Press seams to plain squares.

Sew rows together. Press seams to center. Block should measure 12-1/2".
