

Block of the Month



Cutting

Cream print:

Cut six $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut diagonally once.
Cut two $6\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut diagonally once.

Light green:


Cut two $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut diagonally once.

Red (or pink):


Cut four $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut diagonally once.

Assembly


1. Sew small cream and red triangles together, as shown below. Note pressing arrows. Add green triangles, to make the rosebud units. Press seams to green triangles.



2. Add large cream triangles. Press seams to cream triangles. Make four units.



3. Arrange units to make the Rosebud block.
Sew into rows. Press seams toward light triangle. Sew rows together.
Block should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".
