

## Fabric and Cutting

White Fabric:

Any Pink, Orange or Green (in any order)

A - Cut 1 - 2

B - Cut 2 - 2" x - 7

Cut 2 - 2" x - 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ "

C- Cut 2 - Cut 2 - 2" x - 12 
$$\frac{1}{2}$$

. Cut 2 - Cut 2 - 2" x - 
$$9\frac{1}{2}$$

## Assembly (use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances

Use log cabin construction method to build the block from the (A block) center out.

Trim the block to 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", being sure the 'A' square is centered at 6  $\frac{1}{4}$ " mark (x)
