### Cutting

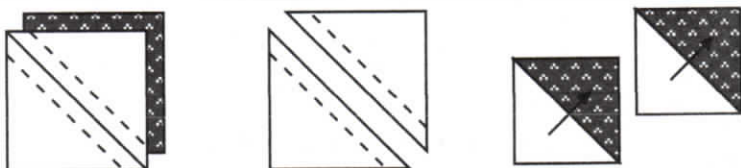
**White** solid or white on white: (4) 4 ½" Squares AND (2) 5 ¼" Squares.

**Pale Blue** solid or small print: (2) 5 ¼" Squares.

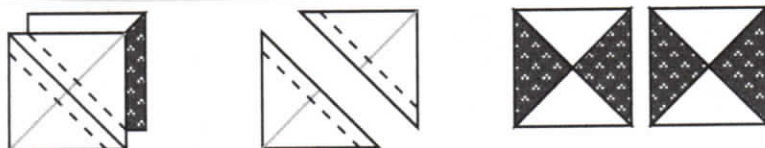
**Ivory** solid or tone on tone print:: (1) 4 ½" Square

### Assembly

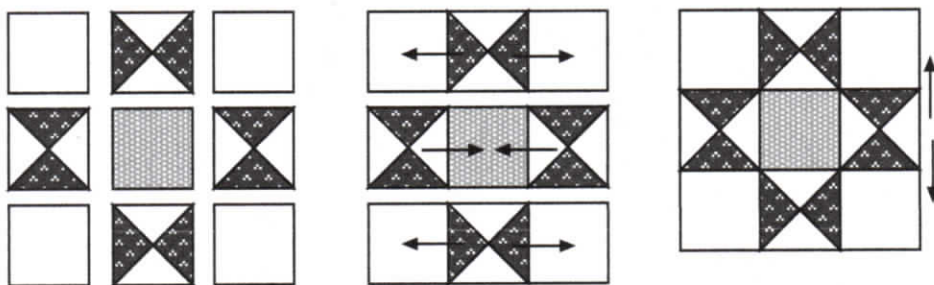
1. Draw a line corner to corner on the wrong side of each White 5-1/4" square. This is a cutting line. Draw a line 1/4" from the cutting line on each side of the line. These are the sewing lines. Pin each white square to a Blue square, right sides together. Stitch on the sewing lines. Cut units apart on the cutting line. Press seam to Blue side. Repeat to make 4 units.



2. Draw a line corner to corner on the wrong side of each unit. This is a cutting line. Draw a line 1/4" from the cutting line on each side of the line. These are the sewing lines. Pin marked unit to another unit, right sides together, as shown. Stitch on the sewing lines. Cut units apart on the cutting line. Press to one side. Repeat to make 4 units. Units should measure 4-1/2".



3. Arrange four quarter square triangle units and five plain squares to make the Ohio Star block. Sew into rows. Press to plain squares. Sew rows together. Block should measure 12-1/2".
