

Coastal Quilters Guild Block of the Month



Fabric and Cutting

For this block, choose primary colors- Red, Yellow and Blue. You can use children's prints or other prints that read as those colors if you have them.

Yellow Fabric Cut 2 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares Cut 2 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares Cut 2 - $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Assembly (use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances

- 1. Sew 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Yellow squares to 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Red squares. Press toward Red.
- 2. Sew 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Yellow rectangles to units from step 1. Press toward Yellow rectangle. Unit should measure 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
- 3. Join Yellow/Red units to Blue squares as shown. Press toward blue squares.
- 4. Join the two rectangular units from step 3 to form the block.
