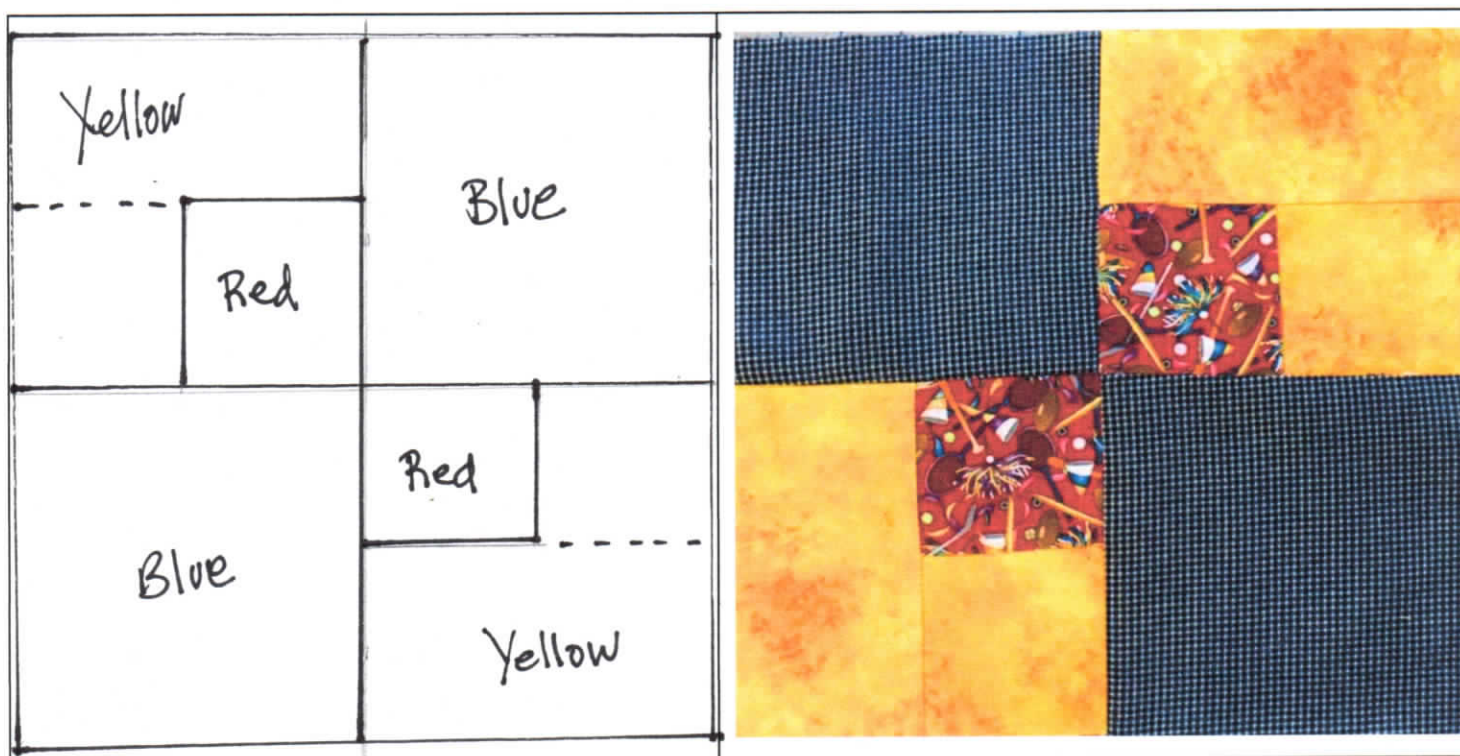


## Tam's Patch

12 x 12" Block (12.5 x 12.5" Unfinished)

Coastal Quilters Guild Block of the Month



### Fabric and Cutting

For this block, choose primary colors- Red, Yellow and Blue. You can use children's prints or other prints that read as those colors if you have them.

<u>Red Fabric:</u> Cut 2 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares	<u>Yellow Fabric</u> Cut 2 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares Cut 2 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares	<u>Blue Fabric</u> Cut 2 - $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

### Assembly (use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances)

1. Sew  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Yellow squares to  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Red squares. Press toward Red.
2. Sew  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Yellow rectangles to units from step 1. Press toward Yellow rectangle. Unit should measure  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
3. Join Yellow/Red units to Blue squares as shown. Press toward blue squares.
4. Join the two rectangular units from step 3 to form the block.
