CLASS DESCRIPTION

Nature is an endless source of beauty and inspiration. With this in mind, learn how to get rid of the "flat" look and turn fabric into something interesting. STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

All fabrics for this class need to be SOLIDS OR HAND-DYED COTTON.

24X24" piece of thin cotton batting.

1/2 yard cheese cloth (found @ grocery stores in package).

1/4 yard dark brown fabric.

1/2 yard medium yellow-green (think lemons) fabric.

1/2 yard white fabric.

Paper/fabric scissors.

Pencil.

Purple disappearing pen (air).

Basic sewing supplies.

Three bobbins filled with cream or white thread.

Spools of thread; yellow, brown, white and light green.

\$12.00 lab fee for design sheet, cording.

Sewing machine; (bring "closed" free motion foot).

Two irons.

Two ironing boards.
