Make A Baby Quilt With Curved Templates Of Your Own Design

In the past, you may have bought a plastic template to make a certain quilt block. Now you can design and make your own curved templates for repeated blocks.

We start with the basics of making templates (from freezer paper!) and move to a confident approach for sewing curved seams (that are flat!).

The workshop project is a simple baby quilt filled with easy, repeated blocks—made with your own templates.



Sewing machine and gear—such as thread, ripper etc.

Fine pins (highly recommend Clover Fine Patchwork Pins #2507)

Good fabric scissors, paper scissors

Cutting tools—24" or larger cutting mat, 24" grid ruler, rotary cutter

Pencil; eraser; colored pencil; fat Sharpie pen; and fabric marking pen

Freezer paper

Iron and ironing board

Fabrics

FQs of 8 solids in a similar palette (eg, greens or blues)

1/2 yard each of 3 patterned fabrics that coordinate with each other and contrast with the solids

1 FQ of one additional patterned fabric that looks good with your palette
