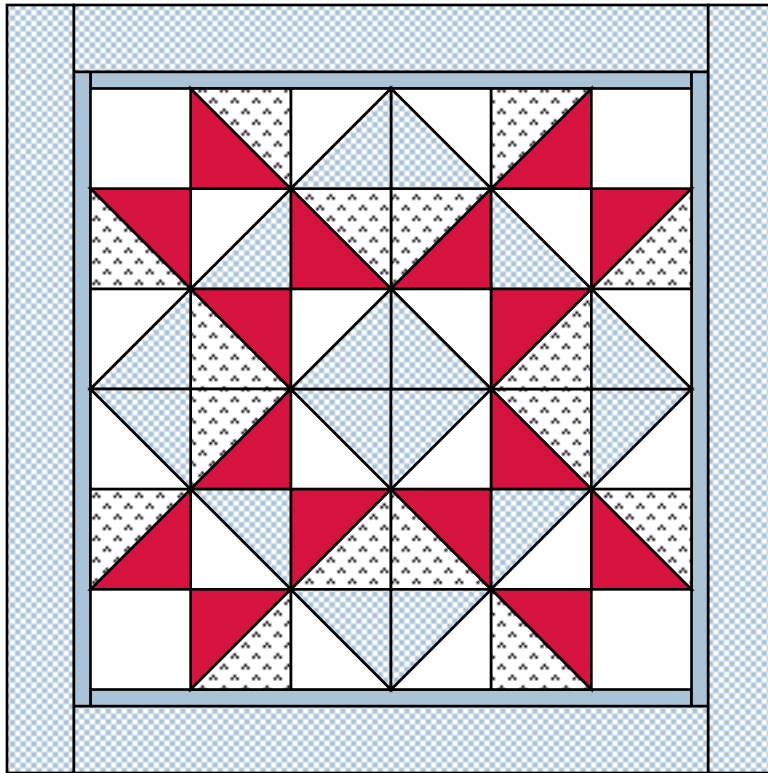


Indian Puzzle

Fabrics Needed:

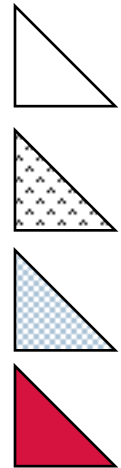
Triangle Units:

Light: 2/3 yard.
Sample has off white print.

Light Medium: 1/2 yard.
Sample has gold print.

Medium: 1/2 yard.
Sample has blue print.

Dark: 1/2 yard.
Sample has red print.



Inner borders: 1/4 yard

Outer borders: 1-1/2 yards

Backing: 1-1/2 yards (plus some piecing)

Binding: 1/2 yard

Cutting:

Triangle Units:

Light: Cut eight 7-1/4" squares and four 6-1/2" squares.

Light Medium: Cut eight 7-1/4" squares.

Medium: Cut eight 7-1/4" squares.

Dark: Cut eight 7-1/4" squares.

Inner borders: *Cut cross grain.*

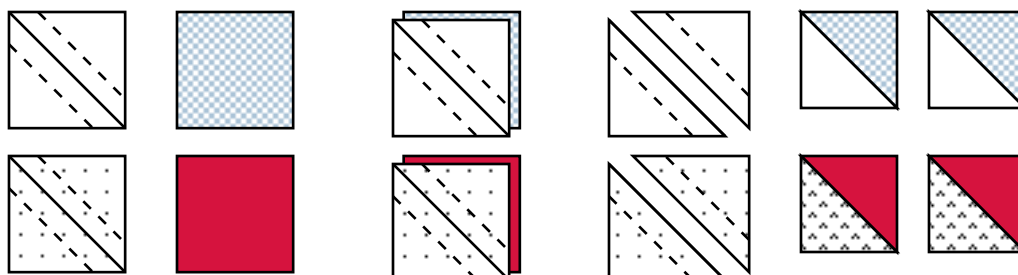
2 borders 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" and 2 borders 1-1/2" x 38-1/2"

Outer borders: *Cut along the lengthwise grain.*

2 borders 4-1/2" x 38-1/2" and 2 borders 4-1/2" x 46-1/2"

Assembly

1. Draw a line corner to corner on the light and light medium squares. This is the cutting line. Draw a line 1/4" from the cutting line and on each side of the cutting line. These are the sewing lines. Pin light squares and medium squares right sides together. Pin light medium squares and dark squares right sides together. Sew on the sewing lines. Cut on the cutting lines. Press seams to the medium or dark. Trim units to 6-1/2". Make 16 units of light and medium fabrics. Make 16 units of light medium and dark fabrics.



2. Referring to the quilt diagram, arrange the triangle units to make the quilt pattern. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Add inner then outer borders.
